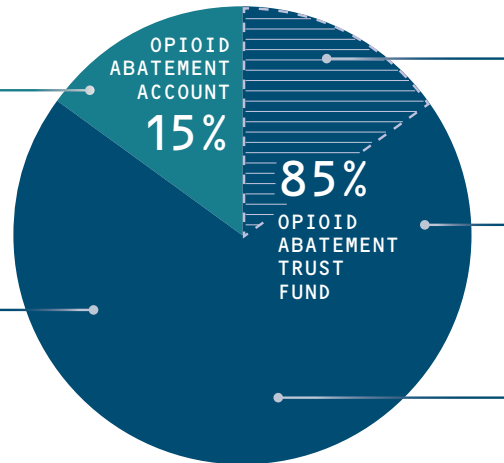

OPIOID ABATEMENT FUND COUNCIL

## FINANCING BREAKDOWN

- 15% of the total amounts received goes to the Opioid Abatement Account which is overseen by the Texas Legislature.
- 85% goes to the Opioid Abatement Trust Fund.



Of the 85% dedicated to the Opioid Abatement Trust Fund:

**15%** of the total settlement  
**SUBDIVISION SHARE**

Distributed to counties and municipalities

**\$5 MILLION**

One-time allocation to Texas Access to Justice Foundation

**REMAINING FUNDS**  
**TRUST FUND SHARE**

After 1% is given to the Comptroller for administration, these funds are managed by the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council (OAFC) with distributions to hospital districts and competitive grants

## AUTHORIZATIONS



**\$100.9 MILLION**  
**TOTAL AUTHORIZED FOR DISTRIBUTION TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS**

- \$47.1 million authorized in March 2023
- \$9.2 million authorized in April 2024
- \$44.7 million authorized in April 2025



**\$80.0 MILLION TOTAL AUTHORIZED FOR DISTRIBUTION TO 154 HOSPITAL DISTRICTS**

- \$65.8 million authorized in August 2024
- \$14.3 million authorized in May 2025

### Notes:

(1) In addition to funds above there is \$1.4 Million in Unappropriated General Revenue. These funds must be appropriated by the Texas Legislature.

(2) The Abatement Account and Trust Fund shares are calculated after attorney fees are paid under the settlement agreements.
