

MAKING IT OFFICIAL:

CERTIFYING THE 2026-2027 TEXAS STATE BUDGET

Following recent regular and special sessions, the Comptroller certified the revenue estimates of funding available for the fiscal 2026-27 biennium. This estimate updates revenue projections to account for the latest economic data and all enacted legislative changes.

JUNE 9, 2025 Date the Comptroller certified the budget.

THE BIG NUMBER: **\$338 BILLION**
That's how much Texas state government will spend over the next two years.



\$149.2 BILLION
The portion of the 2026-27 budget that is General Revenue spending.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY COME FROM?

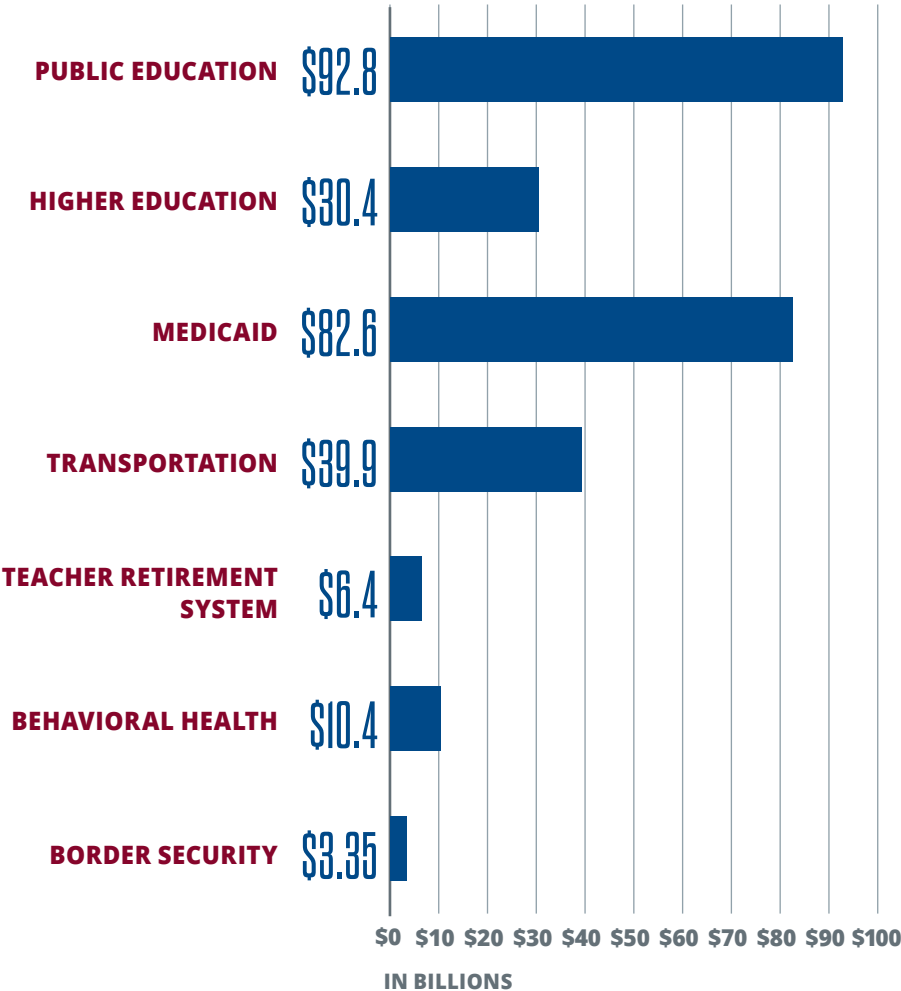
- State taxes
- Federal grants, allocations, payments and reimbursements
- Fees, fines, trust fund revenue, bond proceeds and other nontax revenue

THE PROCESS:

The budget process can be divided into four major phases, each involving numerous discrete steps:

- Planning and proposal
- Legislative action
- Review and approval by the Comptroller and the Governor
- Implementation and monitoring
