Texas A&M University continues its commitment to good faith efforts for HUB participation in the university's procurement opportunities. This commitment extends from Texas A&M University System Policies 25.06 and 25.06.01 regarding HUB participation by all System members.


Historically, this supplemental letter would cite Texas A&M's efforts via reporting on in-person HUB events. Following state and university guidelines with respect to COVID-19, the university did not conduct in-person events during the reporting period. As conditions permit, Texas A&M will resume these in-person activities.

Texas A&M sponsored and hosted a virtual HUB vendor meeting with its prime contractor for on-campus dining. Texas A&M virtually attended the Southwest Minority Supplier Council 2020 Premier, the Houston Minority Supplier Development Council 2020 Expo and the Statewide HUB Program/DIR HUB development session.

As follows is bid data for Texas A&M University-College Station (711) for the period of 9/1/20 – 2/28/21: 9,959 total bids sent; 4,926 sent to HUBs (49.5%) with 239 responses (yield rate = 4.9%)

As follows is bid data for Texas A&M University at Galveston (718) for the period of 9/1/20-2/28/21: 400 total bids sent; 154 sent to HUBs (38.5%) with 4 total responses (yield rate =2.6%)
