

711/709/718 - Fiscal 2025 Semi-Annual HUB Report Supplemental Letter

Texas A&M University (711), Texas A&M University Health Science Center (709), and Texas A&M University at Galveston (718) continue their commitment to good faith efforts by supporting to the greatest extent possible HUB participation in university procurement opportunities.

During this period, Texas A&M University HUB Program hosted, sponsored, and and/or participated in multiple outreach events including Texas A&M HUB Construction Expo (Hosted); Texas A&M at Galveston HUB Expo (Hosted); Greater Houston Business Procurement Forum; DMV HUB Expo; Texas HUB + DBE Expo; SWMBO Bexar County HUB Expo; HDWG Monthly Meetings; TAMUS Monthly HUB Roundtable; Individualized Forums (2) – Bid Source Technology, 1Stop HUB; and B/CS Chamber of Commerce Community Impact Awards (Sponsor).

The following bid data is reported for the period of 9/1/2024 – 2/28/2025.

For Texas A&M University the Total Bids Sent to HUBs was 1692. The Total Responses by HUBs was 138, resulting in a Percentage Rate of Responses of 8.2%. The Total Bids Sent was 3332, resulting in a Percentage of Bids Sent to HUBs of 50.8%.

For Texas A&M University Health Science Center the Total Bids Sent to HUBs was 38. The Total Responses by HUBs was 11, resulting in a Percentage Rate of Responses of 28.9%. The Total Bids Sent was 269, resulting in a Percentage of Bids Sent to HUBs of 14.1%.

For Texas A&M University at Galveston the Total Bids Sent to HUBs was 3. The Total Responses by HUBs was 0, resulting in a Percentage Rate of Responses of 0%. The Total Bids Sent was 23, resulting in a Percentage of Bids Sent to HUBs of 13.0%.

Texas A&M University, Texas A&M University Health Science Center, and Texas A&M University at Galveston remain steadfastly committed to the Texas HUB Program and broadening avenues for HUB vendors. This commitment underscores its belief in fostering diversity and inclusion within the procurement process, ensuring equitable access to opportunities and fostering a vibrant ecosystem of suppliers.
