Supplemental Letter for Fiscal Year 2025 Semi-Annual HUB Report
Angelo State University – Agency Number 737

Angelo State University (“ASU”) is providing this letter to supplement the Semi-Annual Historically Underutilized Business (“HUB”) Report. This letter serves to summarize ASU’s efforts to increase procurement opportunities for HUB vendors and support outreach efforts to businesses potentially qualified for HUB certification. Even though ASU’s distant location in West Texas is a challenge to doing business with some HUB vendors, ASU supported the State HUB Program as outlined below:

- Participated in the State of Texas HUB Development Work Group (HDWG) meetings.
- Attended the 2024 NAACP Texas State Conference on October 10th in Corpus Christi.
- Participated in the 10/29/24 TDLR 2nd Annual Breaking Boundaries HUB Expo.
- Attended the 12/11/24 Bexar County Small, Minority, Women, and Veteran Business Conference.
- Contacted expiring and inactive HUBs to encourage them to renew their certifications.
- Introduced HUBs to internal departments and facilitated the onboarding process with ASU.
- Sponsored 3 mentor/protégé agreements during fiscal year 2025.

The decline in ASU’s overall HUB spend and utilization compared to our FY2024 semi-annual time-period is partly due to SHI Government Solutions, Inc. becoming ineligible for HUB status, and we did not find an alternate HUB vendor in time to procure FY2025 services. In FY2025, ASU is procuring travel from a HUB vendor, Groopie Texas, LLC, and some of our grant funds procured from HUB vendors, which both are not reflected in the FY2024 Semi-Annual HUB report since travel is not a reportable object code and grant funds are excluded from reporting.

ASU will continue supporting the State of TX HUB Program as we search for opportunities to include HUB vendors in our procurement process and expand our outreach efforts. If you have any questions, please contact me at (325) 486-6844 or jennifer.lennon@angelo.edu.
