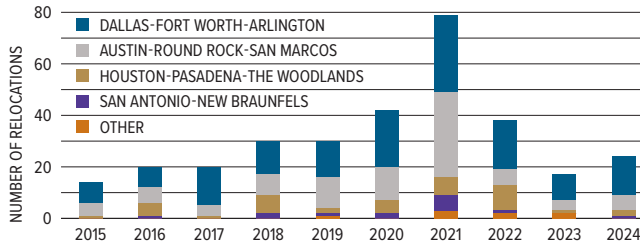
HEADQUARTERS indicates the primary executive location of a company of any size.

FORTUNE 500 COMPANY is one of the 500 largest based on gross total annual revenue.

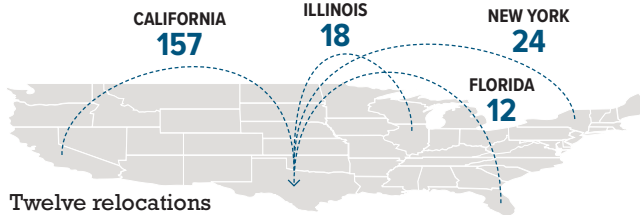
SINGLE ESTABLISHMENT FIRM is a business operating out of one location.
