

## Unincorporated Political Committee Statement to End Franchise Tax Responsibility in Texas – for Entity with No Reports Due

Senate Bill 1, 82nd Legislature, 1st Called Session, amended the definition of a taxable entity in Tax Code Section 171.0002 by adding an unincorporated political committee that is organized under the Election Code or the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. Section 431 et seq.) to the list of entities in Subsection (c) that are not subject to the tax.

Before the passage of this provision, all political committees, incorporated and unincorporated, were taxable entities and subject to the franchise tax. Like all taxable entities, political committees were required to file a franchise tax report, even if no tax was due.

## What You Need to Do

An unincorporated political committee that <u>has filed</u> the 2008 through 2011 franchise tax reports is required to send a statement (provided below for your convenience) to our office <u>prior to May 15, 2012</u>. When we receive this information, we will end the franchise tax responsibility for the political committee. No additional filings are required.

The statement below should **ONLY** be completed and returned by an unincorporated political committee that has filed the 2008 through 2011 franchise tax reports.

## What You Need to Do

An unincorporated political committee that <u>has not filed</u> all franchise tax reports is required to send a statement (provided below for your convenience) to our office <u>prior to May 15, 2012</u>. To satisfy the franchise tax filing responsibilities for the 2008-2011 franchise tax reports, the political committee is also required to include a statement that annualized total revenue for the 2008-2011 franchise tax reports is under the no tax due threshold, if applicable, or the political committee must file the appropriate franchise tax report for each year. When this information is received, we will end the franchise tax responsibility for the political committee. No additional filings are required.

This statement should **ONLY** be completed and returned by an unincorporated political committee that **has not filed** franchise tax reports for 2008 through 2011.
