GENERAL INFORMATION: Pursuant to Tax Code Section 41.413(g), this form is for use only by a lessee who is contractually obligated to reimburse the property owner for taxes imposed on the property to designate a person to act as the lessee's agent in property tax matters. This designation is required to be made in the manner provided by Tax Code Section 1.111. An agent designated directly by a lessee under Tax Code Section 41.413 has the same authority and is subject to the same limitations as an agent designated by a property owner under Tax Code Section 1.111.

NOTE: A lessee who has been designated previously by the property owner under Tax Code Section 1.111(a) as the property owner's agent (as shown by execution of Form 50-162, Appointment of Agent for Property Tax Matters), may not use this form to subsequently designate a person to act as the lessee's agent under Tax Code Section 1.111(a-1) for that property.

FILING INSTRUCTIONS: This document must be filed with the appraisal district office. The designation does not take effect with an appraisal district or a taxing unit in that county until a copy of the designation is filed with the appraisal district. Do not file this document with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts.
