



Texas Application for Certification as a Qualifying Large Data Center Project

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TEXAS COMPTROLLER OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS

This application is used to obtain a registration number that can be used by a qualifying owner, occupant or operator of a qualifying large data center project to claim an exemption from Texas state and local sales and use tax for the purchase of tangible personal property that qualifies for exemption under Texas Tax Code Section 151.3595.

General Information

Requirements for Certification as a Qualifying Large Data Center Project

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions on or after May 1, 2015, for certification as a “large qualifying data center project”:

1. The qualifying owner, operator or occupant of the applicant data center must, jointly or independently, commit to:
 - creating at least 40 qualifying jobs in the county in which the large data center project is located, not including jobs moved from one Texas county to another;
 - making or agreeing to make a capital investment of at least \$500 million in that particular data center over a five-year period. The five-year period will begin on the date the data center is certified by the Comptroller as a qualifying large data center project; and
 - contract for at least 20 megawatts of transmission capacity for operators of the qualifying large data center project.
2. The applicant large data center project must be used, or have a pending contract for use, by a single qualifying occupant who has placed, or will place, tangible personal property used for the processing, storage and distribution of data within the data center. The single qualifying occupant may not be a telecommunications provider or place tangible personal property that is used to deliver telecommunications services within the data center. In addition, the single qualifying occupant cannot sublease any portion of the real or personal property within the qualifying large data center project.
3. The applicant data center must:
 - be, or will be, located in Texas;
 - have, or will have, at least 250,000 square feet of space in one or more buildings located on a single parcel of land or contiguous parcels of land commonly owned or owned by affiliation with the qualifying operator;
 - be, or will be, specifically constructed or refurbished for use primarily as a facility to house servers and related equipment and support staff for the processing, storage and distribution of data;
 - have, or will have, an uninterruptible power source; generator backup power; a sophisticated fire suppression and prevention system; and enhanced physical security that includes restricted access, video surveillance and electronic systems.

Failure to make the required capital investment, to create 40 qualifying jobs and contract for at least 20 megawatts of transmission capacity within five years of the date of certification will result in revocation of this certification. If revoked, all occupants, owners and operators will be liable for tax, penalty and interest from the date of purchase on any item(s) bought tax free under this certification.

What is a Qualifying Job?

A qualifying job is a full-time, permanent job that pays at least 120% of the county average weekly wage in the county in which the job is based and that will last at least five years from date of its creation.

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General Information (cont.)

Property Tax

A qualifying large data center project is not eligible to receive a sales tax exemption under Tax Code Section 151.3595 if the data center is subject to an agreement limiting the appraised value of the data center's property under Subchapter B or C, Chapter 313.

General Instructions

Required Documentation

Applicants must submit the following information with this application:

- proposed job creation schedule;
- capital investment plan; and
- contract, or proposed contract, for at least 20 megawatts of transmission capacity.

All documents submitted with this application become the property of the Comptroller and will not be returned to the applicant. All information provided in this application, the proposed job creation schedule, the capital investment plan and the contract of transmission capacity is confidential to the extent provided under Tax Code Section 151.027.

37. By signing and submitting this application, I (We) certify that pursuant to Texas Tax Code Section 151.3595, I (We) will:

- (1) make a capital investment of at least \$500 million in the large data center project named in Item 1 of this application over a five-year period beginning on the date the large data center project is certified by the Comptroller as a qualifying large data center project;
- (2) create at least 40 qualifying jobs in the county in which the data center is located;
- (3) contract for at least 20 megawatts of transmission capacity for operation of the large data center project; and
- (4) meet the following requirements for the data center named in Item 1 of this application:
 - have at least 250,000 square feet of space located in one or more buildings located on a single parcel of land or contiguous parcels of land located in Texas;
 - specifically constructed or refurbished and actually used primarily to house servers and related equipment and support staff for the processing, storage, and distribution of data;
 - occupied, leased or otherwise used by a **single** qualifying occupant;
 - will not be used primarily by a telecommunications provider to deliver telecommunications services; and
 - have an uninterruptible power source, generator backup power, a sophisticated fire suppression and prevention system and enhanced physical security that includes restricted access, video surveillance and electronic systems.

I (We) acknowledge that failure to make the required capital investment within five years of the date of certification, create 40 qualifying jobs, contract for at least 20 megawatts of transmission capacity and/or meet the data center requirements in Tax Code Section 151.3595(a)(2) and (d) will result in revocation of this registration, and I am (we are) aware that each person who has a data center registration number revoked may be liable for tax, penalty and interest from the date of purchase on any item bought tax free under this registration.

I (We) further acknowledge that by signing and submitting this application, I (we) agree that the statute of limitations on assessment of tax, penalty and interest on purchases made tax free under this certification is tolled until the fifth anniversary of the date of certification, or until such time as the Comptroller is able to verify that the required capital investment, job creation, contract for transmission capacity and data center requirements in Tax Code Section 151.3595(a)(2) and (d) have been met, whichever is later. In the event that a formal waiver of the statute of limitations under Tax Code Section 111.203 becomes necessary, I (we) acknowledge that a failure to execute such waiver will constitute grounds for revocation of this certification.
