The OAFC was formed to ensure that money recovered through the statewide opioid settlement agreements is allocated fairly and spent to put an end to the opioid crisis in Texas.

FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR DISTRIBUTION TO COUNTIES & MUNICIPALITIES



\$100.9 million

Total authorized for distribution to **more than 1,400** political subdivisions in Texas as of May 2025.



FUNDS AUTHORIZED FOR DISTRIBUTION TO HOSPITAL DISTRICTS

2024 STATEWIDE GRANTS



Naloxone Grant

\$25 million awarded to University Health in Bexar County for Naloxone Training and Distribution in **August 2024**

K-12 Education and Prevention Grant

\$25 million awarded to Texas A&M University Health Science Center for opioid prevention services and education program in **January 2025**

Peer to Peer Workforce Grant

\$10 million awarded to RecoveryPeople to implement strategies that will increase the number of peer support specialists in **April 2025**

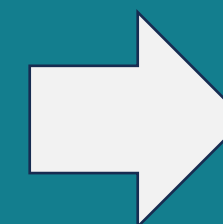
