



TEXAS OVERDOSE PREVENTION

FUNDING DETAILS

- Project Period: November 1st, 2024 -October 31st, 2028 (4 years)
- Funding Amount: \$25 million total
- Funds are allocated to the Regional Healthcare Partnership Regions as outlined by the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council
- Individuals who reside in Texas and are over the age of 18 are eligible



Texas Overdose Prevention is a public health program that **distributes naloxone nasal sprays** and **provides training to individuals** and organizations across the state of Texas. Naloxone reverses the effects of an Opioid overdose, saving lives.

Services are provided at no cost to participants who are 18 years or older and live in Texas. The program also aims to **reduce the stigma** surrounding opioid use.





TEXAS OVERDOSE PREVENTION

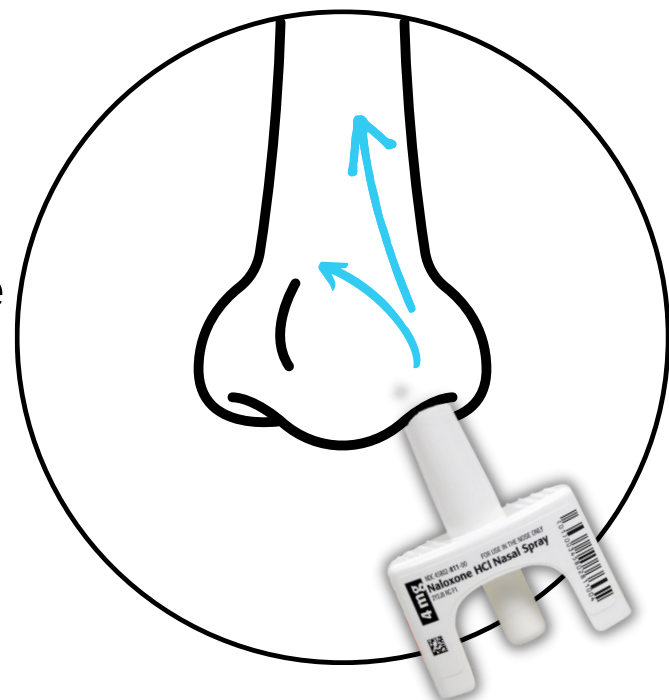
STEP 1 CALL 9-1-1, then carefully remove the Naloxone nasal spray from packaging.



STEP 2 Hold the nasal spray with your thumb on the plunger. Then place the top of the spray in either nostril of the person having an overdose until your fingers are touching their nose.



STEP 3 Firmly press the plunger to release the entire dose of naloxone into the nose.

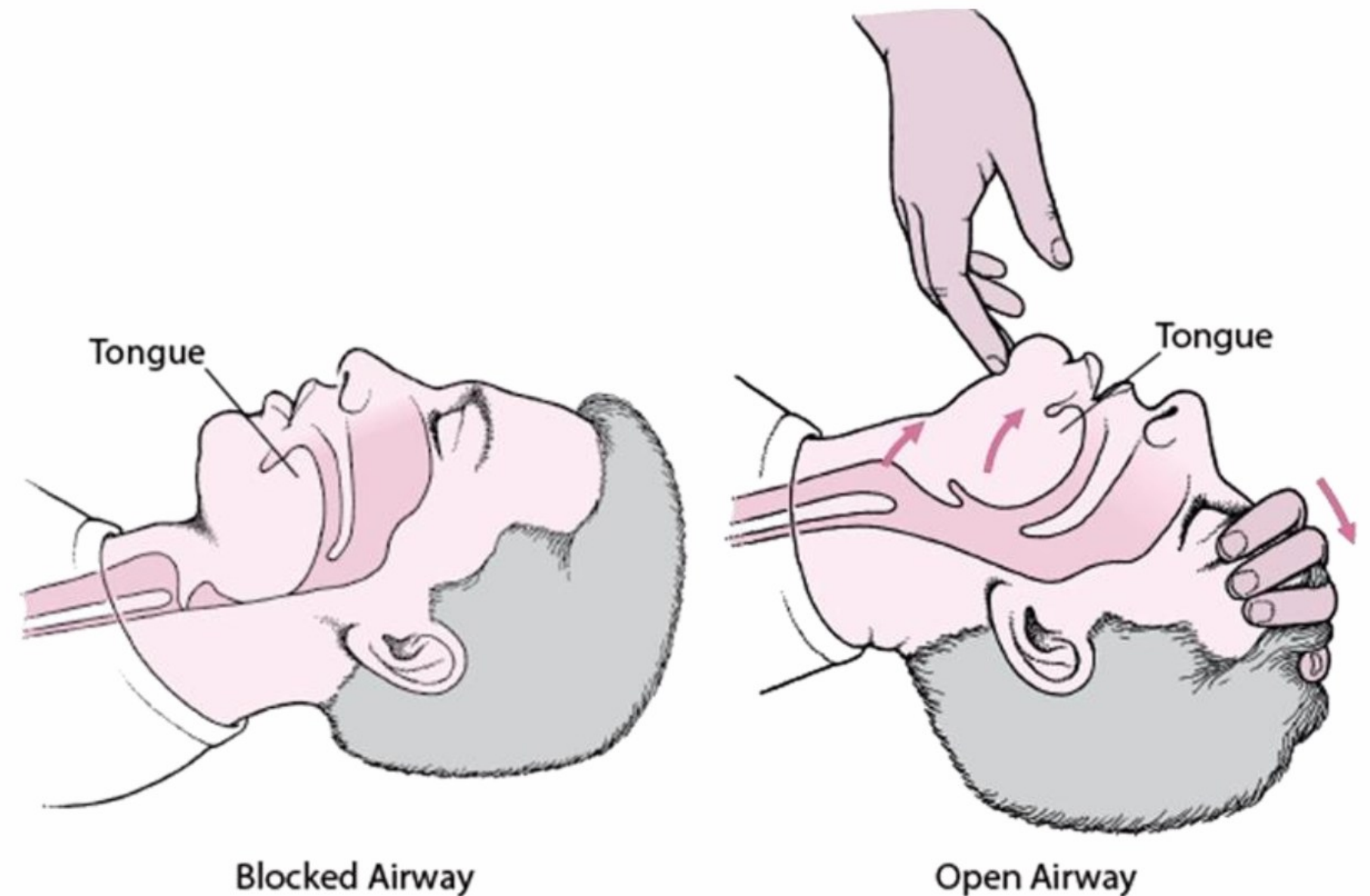


STEP 4 Wait 2-3 minutes for the person to respond. If no response, give more doses, switching nostrils, until help comes.



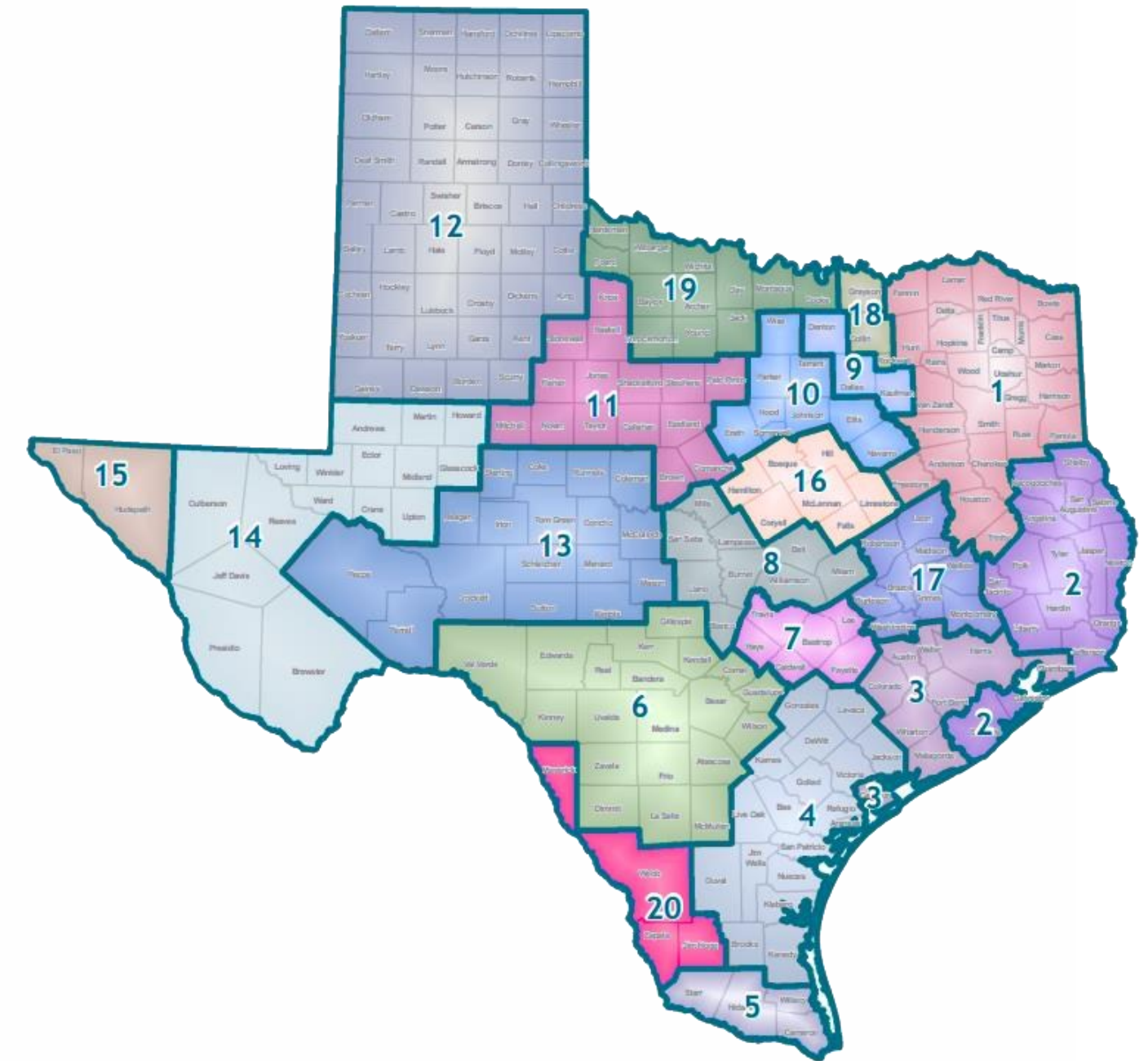
AIRWAY CLEARANCE (ACT)

If an individual is overdosing on opioids and their airway is partially obstructed (due to the position of their body, their tongue blocking the airway, or vomit), performing basic **ACT** can help reestablish an open airway. Proper ACT while awaiting naloxone's effects can maximize the chances of survival and reduce harm caused by the overdose.

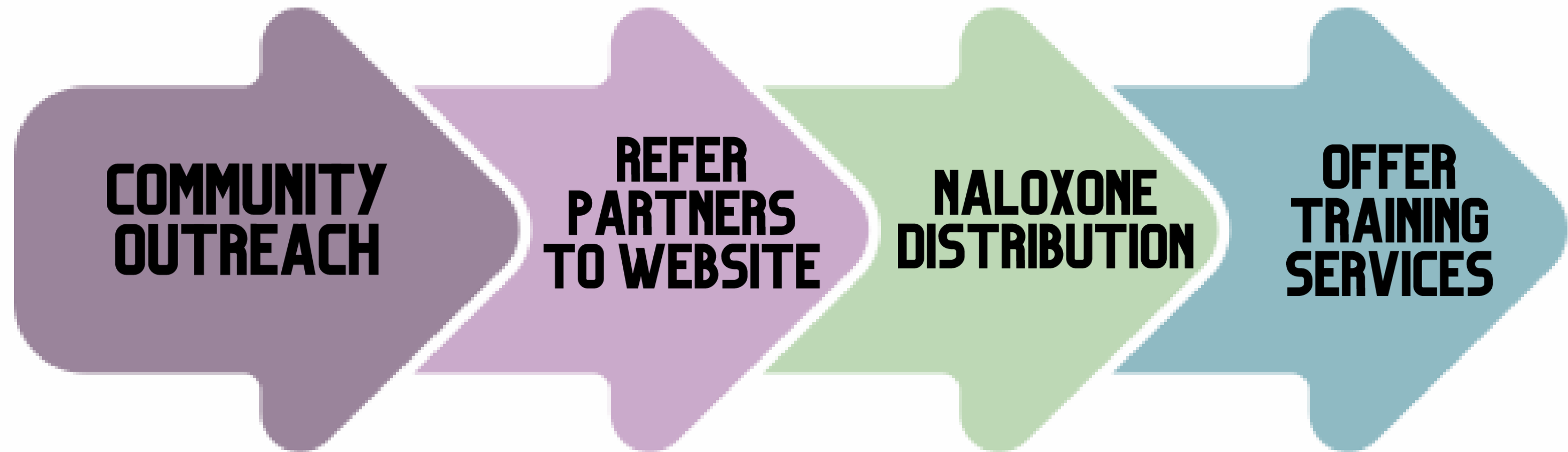


POPULATION OF FOCUS

- Individuals who are in need and organizations that serve populations at the highest risk of opioid overdose.
- The distribution of Naloxone in Texas should reach populations not currently being served by the systems already in place or existing resources.

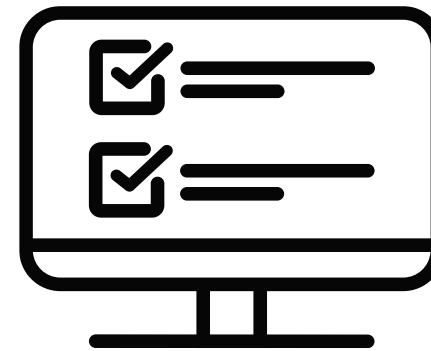

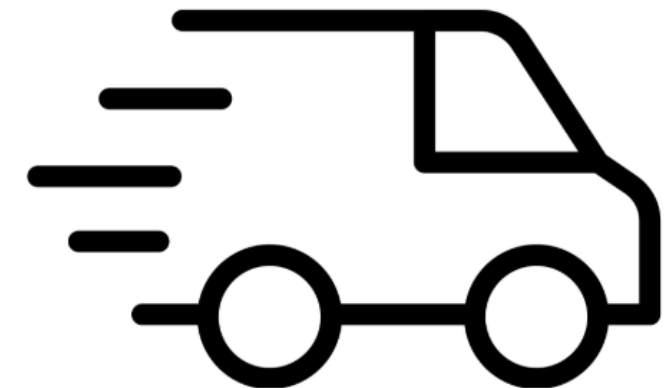
