




- **National Institute of Governmental Purchasing Codes**

- Bidders are encouraged to include the **NIGP codes that best describe** the products or services the business provides in the Vendor Profile.
- It is extremely important to both agencies and potential bidders that **NIGP code selections are correct.**
- **Note: Class Codes 001 to 899 are commodities/products and 900 to 999 are services. Each Class Codes has Item Codes.**


