As a result of the 85th Texas Legislature, through the passing of House Bill 5, on September 1, 2017, the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) became a stand-alone agency and was removed as an agency within the Health and Human Services Commission System.

DFPS is currently reviewing and revising procedures within the Contract Handbook to align with 85th Legislature and new contract management systems.
