Homeowners looking to reduce their property tax bills may find some relief by filing a homestead exemption. A homestead is generally the house and land used as the owner's principal residence on Jan. 1 of the tax year. Homestead exemptions reduce the appraised value of your home and lower your property taxes. Several homestead exemptions are available such as those for disabled veterans or residents age 65 or older.
